Clip Collection – Day of School 17

Grade K
Aug or Sept

Now that we've added today's clip, what do you notice about our Clip Collection? (There is one chain of ten and seven extras; there are seventeen.)

Let's check the number in our Clip Collection. Can we clap for our first chain of ten and count on from there? (10 (clap), 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, **17**)

How will we write **17**? (**1** for one chain of ten clips and **7** for the seven extras.)

How do we read it? (**Seventeen**, or **one group of ten** and **seven extra ones**).

How many days have we come to school **since** Day 10? (Pointing to 10 and helping class count each remaining clip to find the difference.)

If we take one clip off, how many will we have? What if we add one more?

How many more clips until we'll have another full chain of ten? How did you figure this out?
