**Question Starter Card** – *Adapt to any nearby date*. Adapt to any mid September date. If you start school in the summer and are using the August pieces, adapt questions to go with the August green and yellow squares (instead of circles). See *Every Day Counts*, 2005 edition, pages 18 - 21 for questions to add to card.

## Gr. K Calendar – Middle of the Month AUG / SEPT

What do you see when you look at our Calendar now?

Let's count all the days we have had so far this month (1,2,3,4), and so on, up to the current day.) Now let's say the dates. (September  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$ ,  $4^{th}$ , and so on, up to the present.) Can you hear the "th" on the end of  $4^{th}$ ,  $5^{th}$ ,  $6^{th}$ , etc.?

Let's all say the days of the week starting with Sunday?

If today is *Friday*, what was yesterday? (Thursday)

If today is *Friday*, what day of the week will tomorrow be? (Saturday)

Are we at school on the yellow days, Saturday and Sunday?

What will the color of the circle be tomorrow? What made you decide this?

What color will the circle be on \_\_\_\_\_'s birthday? What helped you make your guess?

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
