



## **Coin Counter – Middle of the Month**

**Grade 1  
NOVEMBER  
or Month 3**

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How many pennies can we get for one nickel? (Five pennies or five cents)

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How many nickels do we have? (3 nickels.) Let's count up by fives to find out how much three nickels are worth? (Five, ten, fifteen.)

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Now, let's count the nickels again, clapping on the last nickel, to remind us to stop counting by fives and start counting the pennies by ones. (Five, ten, **fifteen** (clap), sixteen, seventeen.)

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How many more pennies do we need to get our next nickel? (3)

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If we wanted to buy a pencil for 10 cents, do we have enough money? (Yes)  
What coins could we use to pay the 10 cents?

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If I had a piggy bank with only nickels and pennies inside and I took out 3 coins, how much money could I have? (3¢, 7¢, 11¢, or 15¢)

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
